Playing a wide variety of music from the 14th to the 21st centuries, Marg will lead participants through the top line first. In the case of trios, she is joined by her partner, Pete. Marg will make suggestions regarding style and ornamentation as appropriate.



Marg Hall (b.1944) is a recorder player, teacher and composer living near Edinburgh, Scotland. She started learning the recorder as an adult, having earlier played the piano and classical guitar. Her love of the recorder led to full-time study, and then to writing for recorders (mostly published by Peacock Press). She has taught the recorder in the Edinburgh area for many years. In 2005 she won the 'Big Bass Competition' organized by Steve Marshall (MayHill Edition) to write a piece including great and contra basses. In 2012 she was commissioned by the Society of Recorder Players (SRP) to write a jazzy piece to celebrate the 75th birthday of the Society, which appeared in the Recorder Magazine in the summer 2012. She is on the Panel of Visiting Conductors for the SRP and for the last 20 years has conducted recorder groups all over the U.K. She has been a member of the recorder consort 'Solsequium' for many years, and is a member of the Scottish Recorder Orchestra. She is currently enjoying arranging tunes about Scottish islands!
