One of the most compelling things about the recorder is its sound -hauntingly clear, beautifully supple. But achieving that beautiful tone is not easy. In this hybrid session, blending informative lecture with specially selected repertoire, we'll explore five techniques for improving tone- and how we can use them to deepen our enjoyment of the music we love.

Anne Timberlake has appeared across the United States performing repertoire from Bach to twenty-first-century premieres. She holds degrees in recorder performance from Oberlin Conservatory and Indiana University, Critics have described her playing as "dazzling" (Chicago Classical Review) and "preternaturally persuasive" (The Ann Arbor Observer). A Fulbright grantee, Anne won Early Music America's 2011 Naxos Recording Competition with her ensemble Wayward Sisters.
